Harvey, WB5MCT – Repeater reports

Harvey, WB5MCT WB5MCT: All repeaters currently working nominally. The repeater team investigated problems with the 145.190 machine that began with the winter storm of February 13-16, 2021 (According to Wikipedia the costliest Texas winter storm in Texas history with 237 deaths and \$20.4 billion in damages). Extensive tests revealed that the antenna system (antenna and/or feedline) was producing excessive random noise when transmitting at normal power. Experiments with various combinations of equipment and antennas revealed acceptable results when receiving on the top mounted legacy antenna and transmitting on the dual band antenna VARC installed in 2019, and that system is currently in use.

The 145.130, 443.800 and 444.325 repeaters are currently working normally and no work is scheduled for them.
