This net meets every Monday night Net at 8:00 PM, on the W5DSC 145.190 MHz (analog) repeater with the standard VHF, negative offset and PL Tone of 103.5 Hz. If that frequency's repeater is not available or operable, the backup frequencies on W5DSC linked repeaters are 443.350 (analog) and 145.130 (digitally).
